
Parents with children in **new Y7** will need to ensure that they have communicated with school to complete the relevant paperwork and acquire uniform for their child **before the end of this term**.

To access a report for your child on Class Charts with work that they have completed over the period of school closure please follow the following guidance:

Click on 'Behaviour' and then change the time frame to 'Last 90 days' by clicking on the orange calendar symbol. The pie chart will show an overview of feedback and further details can be seen further down the page.

Click on 'Homework' for an overview of the homework that your child has completed.



If your child is in Y10 you should also have received attendance certificates to show how many lessons your child has participated in. Staff have overwhelmingly reported that attendance has been very good and their students have enjoyed working in this medium. We aim to continue using the Teams platform in a different when school re-opens in September as we see opportunities to support your child catch up the lost work through this platform.
