Dear Families

As you are aware there have been a number of changes issued by the Government over this last week. The Department for Education have issued further advice to schools regarding Plan B and what this means for schools into next term. Based on past experiences we anticipate that over the coming weeks this advice will continue to change so we will do our best to communicate any new information and changes with you as soon as we are able to do so.

Changes to Returning to School

We will be having a staggered return to school in the New Year to enable onsite testing for staff and students to occur, and also to prepare remote learning plans to reduce any potential disruption caused by large numbers of staff and students having to isolate because of the Omicron variant.

As a consequence, school will now resume as follows:

Tuesday 4 January – Y7 and Y8 to return to school as normal and be in for rest of the week.

Wednesday 5 January - Y10 and Y11 to return to school and be in for the rest of the week.

Thursday 6 January – Y9 to return to school and be in for the rest of the week.

Friday 7 January – All year groups will be in school as normal.

We will of course keep everyone up to speed with any Governmental changes. Please continue to check Class Charts for updates.
