Action	Description
Closing the gap programme	Involves increased literacy support for students within the group with an increased focus in lessons on literacy. As the group has 3 members of staff and at least one support assistant for 18 lessons a week this allows progress. Use of phonics with this group.
Literacy intervention programmes	Toe by Toe phonics interventions for literacy.
Small group intervention programme	Taught by CWL.
Dedicated Key Skills lesson in Year 7	Materials sourced by the literacy co-ordinator used to support.

Numeracy -

Action	Description
Power of 2	Delivered during tutor time by a 'buddy' system. Power of 2 materials.
Peer Mentoring Programme	Each Year 7 has a Year 9 peer mentor who delivers the Springboard 7 materials during tutor time.
Intervention	Students use appropriate schemes as above and in the summer term any who are not making sufficient progress receive more intensive support from Maths teachers (KG as member of staff in charge of Key Stage 3 Maths) to co-ordinate.
Dedicated Key Skills lesson in Year 7	Materials sourced by the maths department used to support.

Literacy	Updated standardised literacy scores from September 15-July 16 demonstrate progress overall.
Numeracy	A&A grades demonstrate progress over time.
