The **Working Together Team** are all qualified teachers who have additional qualifications, expertise and experience in working with children and young people who have a diagnosis of Autism or ADHD, although many of the children we see do not have a formal diagnosis of any condition. We were commissioned by Lincolnshire County Council in 2015 to ensure these youngsters in school receive the appropriate support in school.

The Autism Education Trust

The Autism Education Trust (AET) is dedicated to co-ordinating and improving education support for all children on the autism spectrum in England. (NAS)

The AET provides a comprehensive training programme and the Working Together Team deliver many of these modules to teachers, support staff and other colleagues who work in our schools. To date, over 8000 members of staff have completed the initial level of training with many more completing subsequent sessions.

Making Sense of Autism

The first stage of providing any effective support is to 'know' and 'understand' the nature of any differences. This is the focus of this session and the WTT are delighted to be able to offer this to parents who may find it useful - especially if you are new to a diagnosis for your child, feel you have never really understood what it means or you may suspect your child displays some common traits.
